Dear Laurel View Village Community:

We continue to move forward in opening things back up and wanted to communicate where we currently are in that process. We are grateful to say both Health Care and Personal Care are moving forward in their three steps of reopening.

Personal Care: Moving into Step 3 of reopening as of August 13. Families coming on campus to transport their family member to medical appointments must come into the main lobby and complete the screening process to ensure safety of residents and contact tracing. Health Care: Moving into Step 2 of reopening as of August 15. This will allow outside in person visits, which can be scheduled through life enrichment department and the beauty salon services to start again. Independent Living: Visitors can come to Independent Living homes (Vista, Cambridge and Townhomes). We ask that the visitors continue to stay to the residents' homes and not congregate in common areas. **We highly discourage visitors from** states that are listed by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as "hot spots" of COVID-19 cases. It is recommended that all people traveling to and from these states quarantine for 14 days at home. Should you travel or have someone travel to you from these states we ask that you self-isolate for 14 days. Should a resident stay off campus for multiple days or have an overnight stay in the hospital, we ask that you receive a COVID-19 test and self-isolate.

Reminder to all residents and families – remember while you are out in the greater community or even in community areas on campus, please continue to remember the three W's – **Wear a face mask, Watch your distance, and Wash your hands.** If you have questions regarding any of this, please do not hesitate to reach out to administration. Again, we continue to thank you for your patience and support. Thank you everyone for all your are doing to keep residents and team members safe.
